## General Rules

1. Faire hours are Saturday, May 1, and Sunday, May 2, from 10 am to 6 pm. Booths can be set up Friday, April 30, after 12 Noon and must remain up and running until after 6 pm on Sunday, May 2.
2. **No vehicles/trailers/vans will be allowed on Faire Grounds after initial setup. All Rv's must stay at an RV park or campground where power and water are available - NO exceptions.**
3. Booth spaces are 10'x10' in an open, outside area. Each Vendor must furnish their own tables, chairs, tents, etc. Vendors are strongly encouraged to dress and decorate their booth in a Renaissance theme. Vendors should be prepared for the possibility of inclement weather such as wind and rain. Tents should be properly secured. This is a RAIN or SHINE event.
4. Booth assignments made upon check-in.
5. A Faire Representative will collect applicable MS State Sales tax of 7% at the end of each day. An additional 2% Food & Beverage tax will be collected from all food and drink booths. Per MS Tax Commission ruling, tax numbers WILL NOT be accepted.
6. Exhibitors bear the responsibility for all setup and security for their exhibits. Neither St. John's Episcopal Church nor its representatives will be responsible for loss, damage or injury of any kind.
7. In order to maintain the quality of our Faire the committee will review your application to limit duplication of craft or food items. This is a family-oriented Faire for all ages and work or wares must be appropriate. The Faire Committee reserves the right to remove wares i.e. WICCA or Dark Arts items, that are not in keeping with the integrity of the event.
8. All Food Booths are responsible for any required items or conditions for inspection by the Jackson County Health Department prior to 10 am, Saturday, May 1.
9. An accepted application is a commitment to exhibit and NO refund will be made for cancellations, including inclement weather - NO exceptions.
